

**SYP Angling Club**  
**Directory of Club Waters 2017**

**1. Westwoodside Lakes - Idle Bank Road, Westwoodside, Doncaster, DN9 2BD  
(nearest post code) – Grid Ref: SE 724008**

This fishery consists of two Lakes – Colwyn Lake & Mirlwyn Lake.

Colwyn Lakes has 18 fishing pegs and a central island. Mirlwyn Lake has 17 pegs.

**Directions**

**Postcode** (for Satnav) – **DN9 2BD** (nearest available postcode – this postcode is on Cove Road – and the ponds are actually off the path from Idle Bank Road – approx.. 100 metres to path from this location)

**General Directions**

Follow the main road from Doncaster to Haxey and Westwoodside (B1396). You will pass the commercial Bankend Fishery on the right hand side and then the North Lincolnshire sign on the left hand side. Take the next turning on the left which is directed towards Wroot and Sandtoft. This is Idle Bank Road – a straight bumpy road with a dike running alongside on the left hand side. Take the seventh bridge over the dike after the turning from the B 1396 (just before the 30 mph and uneven surface sign on the left) – there is also a sign to Westwoodside Fishery – a commercial fishery on the left off the lane before you arrive at our lakes. After crossing the dyke, follow the track – passing Westwoodside Fishery and arriving at Colwyn Lake the match Lake – just before the gate across the road at the end of the lane.

There is good car parking at our lakes and in some spots you can drive between the trees to park next to your peg. There is a notice board for Club information and match dates on Colwyn Lake.

The banks are suitable for the less able and a chemical toilet with hand washing facilities is provided during summer months.

**2. Woodsetts Pond Woodsetts Lane, Woodsetts, Nr. Worksop, S81 8AW.**

**Grid Ref: SK 562823**

This pond is owned by the South Yorkshire Police Sports & Social Club and has 12 fishing pegs.

**General Directions**

The best route to the pond is to leave the M1 at Junction 31 and take the A57 towards Worksop. Continue

until passing Lindrick Golf Course, on reaching the Woodsetts Roundabout – take the first exit off the roundabout onto Woodsetts Lane. After about 350 yards you come to a clearly marked gate on the left hand side – this is opposite Owday Lane. Open the gate (combination lock - number issued to members) drive down the lane and continue to the double steel gates on the right hand side (combination lock in use number made available to members). Please lock up behind you and park in the car park behind the steel gates. Please re-scramble the combination locks to assist security.

### **3. Loxley Mill Pond – Loxley Road, Sheffield, S6 4TF**

**Grid Ref: SK 320823**

This pond has no specific pegs. Anglers fish from the bank where this is permitted.

#### **General Directions**

From Malin Bridge, Sheffield follow the signs to Loxley, taking the Loxley Road (B6077). Continue on Loxley Road for approx. 350 metres and then take the first turning on the left into the Loxley Park Retirement Complex. Find a safe place to park and then sign in at the main reception to let the complex know that you are fishing the Mill Dam which is on the west side of the complex. Paths lead directly to the dam.

### **4. River Don, Niagara Conference & Leisure, Niagara Road, Sheffield, S6 1LU**

**Grid Ref: SK 330911**

A short stretch of the river runs through the grounds of the Sports & Social Club grounds. There are no recognised pegs and members fish from suitable places on the natural banks.

#### **Directions**

Follow the A61 Penistone Road past the SWFC ground (on the left - away from City) to the traffic Herries Road. Continue North on the A61 Penistone Road and take the first turning on the left just prior to Sainsbury's Supermarket into – Claywheels Lane then first left into Beeley Wood Road which bends to the left, then turn right into Niagara Road. Continue to the end and into the car park of the SY Police Sports and Social Club. Park near the bowling green and walk toward the large trees at the far end of the sports pitches (directly opposite the club house).

### **5. Chesterfield Canal at Ranby, North Nottinghamshire from Bridge 53 at Barnby Wharf, Old London Road, DN22 8JG, Grid Ref: SK663828 to Lock 53, Osberton Lock, Scofton Village, Osberton Estate, Nottinghamshire, S81 OUE – Grid Ref: SK 631800.**

#### **Directions**

(1) **Barnby Wharf** - from the A1 take the A620 (Straight Mile) towards Retford travelling East. Continue on the A620 for just over a mile and you will see HM Prison Ranby on the left. Take the first left turn after the prison signposted Barnby Moor – continue for just less than a mile and you will reach a bridge (no 53) over the canal – immediately over the bridge turn right and park on the hard standing. The Club water commences to the right of the car park after bridge 53.

**(2) Bridge 52, Green Mile Lane.**

Take the first left after the prison as described at 1 above, about half a mile on the left is a tall beech hedge and a sign for Green Mile Trees. Turn left here down Green Mile Lane until you reach bridge 52 where there is parking for about six cars. Towards the bottom of the lane it can become overgrown with brambles etc. so a pair of clippers may be required to prevent your car being scratched.

**(3) In the Ranby Estate, Barracks Bend, DN22 8JQ – Grid Ref: SK651824** on reaching bridge 53 continue towards Barnby Moor for about quarter of a mile and take the first left signed A1. After about a third of a mile there is a single track tarmac road on the left, take this towards Ranby Hall, follow it round to the right. On reaching the concrete surface near the farm continue to the cross roads. Turning left here will bring you to bridge 52 but the road is very rutted and only suitable for 4 wheel drives or big vehicles. Going straight across will bring you to the side of the canal near the Barracks bend; parking is available off the track between the trees. Please do not obstruct gates and the track as they are used by farm vehicles.

**(4) Ranby Village/The Barracks** – cars can be parked on Old Blyth Road alongside the A1 – the A1 is on the left and the canal on the right.

**(5) Bridge 51 Ranby Village**

Parking is not permitted on the access road between the canal and the houses. On street car parking is available on Old Blyth Road in the village. Please park sensibly.

**(6) Osberton Lock -**

From Worksop take the B 6079 to Retford. A mile and a half after the traffic island/railway bridge at Manton the road drops downhill with trees on your nearside. Take the left turn, opposite a bus stop, into the Osberton Estate. Passing through the first gate carry straight onto to the security gate which is normally closed. To request access/exit please ring one of the mobile numbers displayed. You will need to be able to provide proof of current SYPAC Membership.

Proceed down the drive and a canal side cottage on the left comes into view. Immediately over the canal bridge as the road bends to the left you will see a car park next to the canal. This is the Anglers Car Park, remove the chain and park your vehicle sensibly bearing in mind the needs of others. Replace the chain. This is the only permitted parking area in the Estate. Parking is not permitted on any other areas, roads or tracks within the Estate.

**6. Tidal Trent at Littleborough, Nottinghamshire.**

**From the foreshore at Littleborough Village. Post code DN21 5AY. Grid Ref: SK 8248264 to West Burton Power Station. Post code DN22 9BL. Grid Ref: SK 806857.**

The Club holds the fishing rights on 3 ½ miles of western bank of the Tidal Trent from Littleborough to West Burton Power Station. This is an agreement negotiated annually and confirmed in an exchange of letters with the Foljamb Estate. An annual rent is paid. There are no pegs and members fish at suitable places on the river bank.

**Directions**

From the A626 Retford to Gainsborough Road turn right at the Sun Inn onto Lowe Street towards North Wheatley. Follow the road through South Wheatley to Sturton Le Steeple where you turn left at the

Reindeer Pub to Littleborough. On reaching the river the old ferry is directly in front of you, turn to the left and the downstream Club Stretch begins at the first fence & style. The upstream stretch is the first meadow beyond River Cottage: post code **DN21 5AY**. Grid Ref: **SK 824824**

There is also vehicular access to the river from Littleborough Road via Long Farm Lane, Upper Ings Lane and Knaith Hall Lane giving access to the river at post code: **DN22 OHB**. Grid Ref: **SK 824844**

Currently there is no access for members vehicles at West Burton Power Station end of the stretch.

***Due to the rural locations of some of the Club Waters the post codes relate to one of the nearest properties.***
